

## AIG SCREENING PROCESS

\*We use two main types of data to inform instruction for enrichment and to make student referral decisions:  
**1) Aptitude Screening -and- 2) Achievement Data**

### **Achievement**

#### K-2 Independent Reading Levels:

Must be one full year advanced at testing time

#### EOG Scores (Grades

3-7): Must be 95% or above on the state EOG in reading or math

### **Aptitude**

#### CogAT Scores:

Must be 92% or above on any subscore (96+%, student will automatically place as Intellectually Gifted)

\*If a student meets the requirements for either achievement or aptitude, the student will be referred for further testing.

\*\*Students **not** referred will continue to be monitored and provided classroom instruction designed by the teacher to enhance talent and abilities.
