**\*\***Since students may have multiple columns marked in the affirmative (e.g., have two GCEs), any affirmative columns other than the primary column (the way a student will be counted for reporting purposes) will be marked with an 'S' for 'Secondary' instead of a 'Y.' The order of precedence from greatest to least is EOG, BOG, RtA, SAV, Portfolio (rpf), ELS, SWD, PRM, PRC. So, the first way the student met in this list will be listed as Primary (Y) in the audit file and all other ways met will be Secondary (S).
